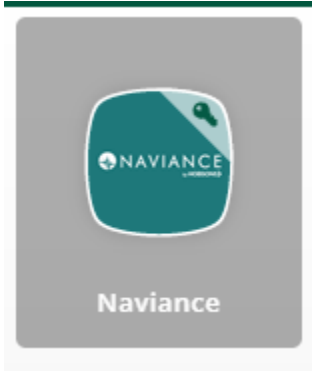


Junior- Bridge Bill Student Instructions

1. Log into Classlink to access the Naviance app.



2. View the Tasks you Need to Work On:

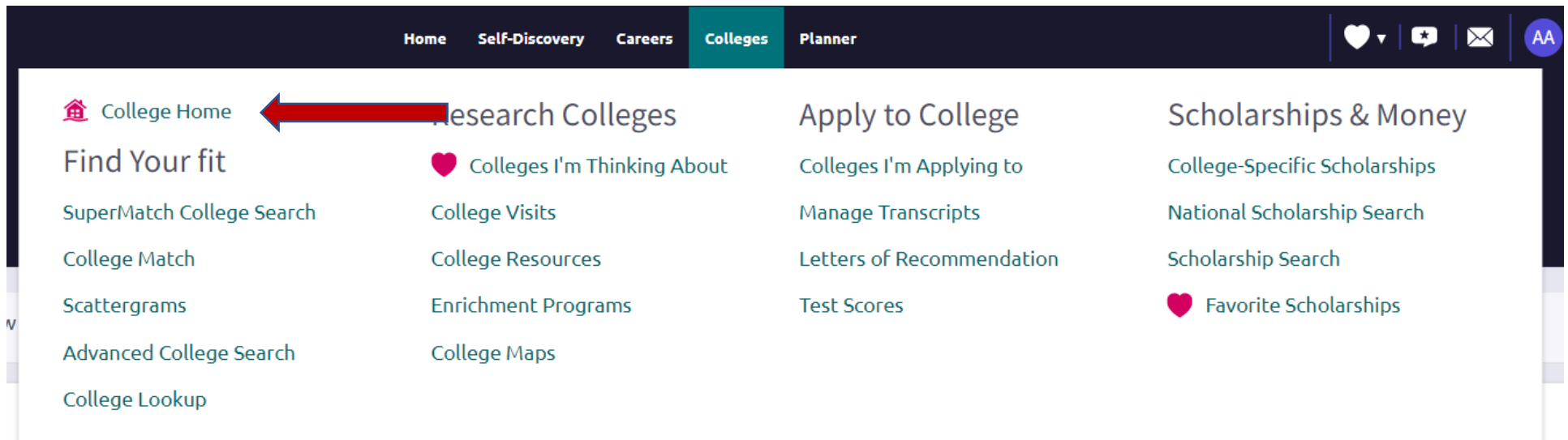

6. Search College

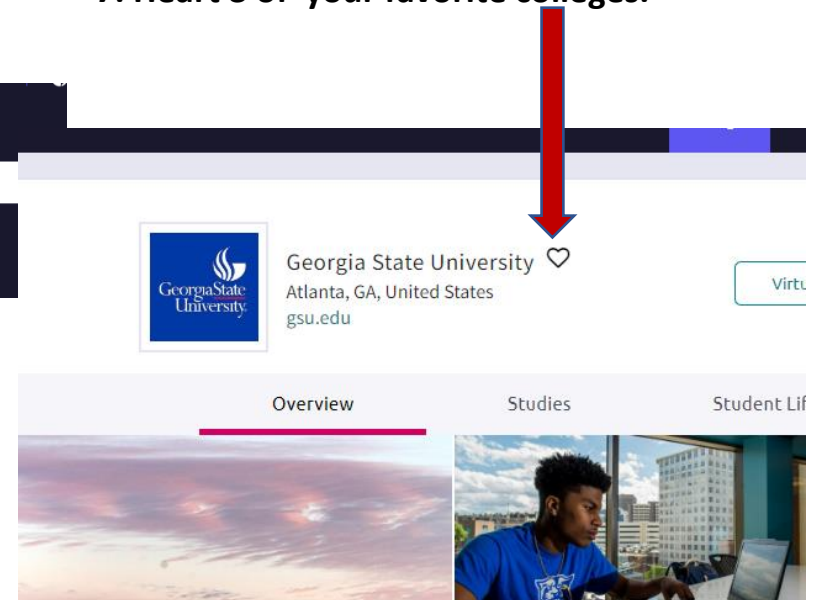
