## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

AP American Gov: Students cultivate their understanding of U.S. government and politics through analysis of data and text- based sources as they explore topics like constitutionalism, liberty and order, civic participation in a representative democracy, competing policymaking interests, and methods of political analysis.

### TEACHER FEEDBACK

#### TIME COMMITMENT:

Approximately 20 minutes daily outside of school.

#### TYPES OF WORK IN THIS COURSE:

Reading outside of class. Complete Foundational Document Readings and complete Supreme Court Case analysis outside of class time. Keep up with current events using a varity of media outlets.

9th graders taking this course should have an above average maturity level to be successful with the content and coursework



### STUDENT FEEDBACK

#### TIME COMMITMENT:

Most students reported that they spend approximately up to 5 hours per week in order to be successful in the AP American Gov course for 9th graders.

#### DIFFICULTY/PACE:

Most students reported that this course was more difficult than other AP courses they've taken and the majority said that the pace was faster than other AP courses as well.
