

TAG at Chattahoochee Overview

TAG offers classes and experiences that only TAG students can participate in.

TAG field trips / seminars – In the past we planned trips to the Alliance Theatre, The Carter Presidential Library, The Museum for Human & Civil Rights, and the Mercedes-Benz Stadium.

TAG Directed Studies: (10th, 11th or 12th) This class is a self-directed class that each individual student decides what they will study. This can be things that are enrichment beyond the class offerings at Chattahoochee (advanced computer sciences, criminal psychology, etc), classes not offered (foreign languages, culinary arts, etc), or extensions of academic extracurriculars (Science Olympiad, Academic Team, LaunchX, etc). We have even supported some community enrichment activities (Eagle Scouts, well being at public schools, etc.). This is a great opportunity which can be either semester or year long. They are allowed to work on their subject during their Directed Studies period and in some cases, also allowed to do it virtually. They will create 9 to 12 gradable, college level projects/assignments that they will complete over the course of the semester which are due at even intervals. Any grade level is allowed to participate, if they can work it into their class schedule. It is considered to be an academic elective and is not a substitute for any required class to graduate.

TAG Internship: (11th & 12th – but must be able to drive & Hire me is a prerequisite) Students in internship will go to an unpaid job for 5 hours a week, for a total of 70 hours a semester. They will get to shadow and work in a field of their choice. This shows them what the real world is like. And lets them see if the career they are thinking about is what they want to be. Internship is a huge resume builder. Colleges love to see that a student already has experience in a field.

Hire me Seminar: A Lunch and Learn Seminar for 10th & 11th graders. This is not a class in their schedule. This is taught in about 10 lunch and learns. It teaches the students how to write a Resume, Cover Letter, Interview Skills, Career Exploration and more. This is a Required Prerequisite for Internship.
