

## Georgia Trip 2019 Rules of the Road



1. The Autrey Mill dress code is in effect throughout the trip. **Pajama pants may not be worn on the bus or outside your hotel room.**
2. Once you have found a seat on the bus, you will need to stay seated until the bus has reached our next stop. Students will not be allowed to move about on the bus.
3. The restrooms on the bus are for **EMERGENCY** use only. Students are not allowed to pour drinks or trash down the sink or toilet.
4. **All drinks must have twist caps.** Also, it is a good idea to package other snacks (such as candy or chips) in resealable zip top bags. Students are responsible for picking up and disposing of their own garbage.
5. You are allowed a backpack and pillow for the bus ride, and a medium sized suitcase which will be stored under the bus. Students must be able to carry their own luggage.
6. Cell phones and personal gaming devices used with headphones at a reasonable volume may be used on the bus. **No other personal electronics are allowed on the bus.** AMMS is not responsible for any lost or damaged items.
7. **School iPads are NOT allowed on the trip.**
8. You must stay with your assigned chaperone at all times.
9. Once you are checked into your room at night, you may not leave until your chaperone comes to you get in the morning. Students must stay in their rooms at the hotels.
10. You are expected to leave your hotel rooms in the same condition you find them. Students are responsible for any damage done to the rooms.
11. Students are not allowed to put any charges on the room, including TV and phone related charges.
12. Students can have cell phones, **but** they are only to be used in the hotel rooms and on buses as allowed. Cell phones **should not** be turned on **or** visible during activities. Cell phone use **should be limited** to calling parents or using as a camera (when permitted).
13. Time is very tight on this trip, so it is extremely important that you are where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there. Buses cannot leave until all students have arrived, and delays will cause us to be late for activities.
14. You are acting as representatives of Autrey Mill Middle School and will be expected to behave responsibly. Students are expected to follow all AMMS and Fulton County rules. Disciplinary consequences will be given for misbehavior, up to and including suspension from school upon our return.
15. All students are expected to obey chaperone requests promptly and without argument.
