



Rising 7th Graders - Please review if you are a current 6th grade parent!

Parents of 6th grade students please review the information regarding the 7th grade immunizations requirements:

Beginning with the 2023-24 school year, children entering 7th grade who were born on or after January 1, 2002, and for new students entering a Georgia school grades 8th through 12th must show proof of receiving the following prior to entering school:

- One dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine; and
- One dose of Meningococcal conjugate vaccine

The Georgia Department of Public Health Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231) is required as proof of the immunizations. This form is available from your healthcare provider or the health department. A list of local health departments and their service hours can be obtained from the school or online at <http://www.fultoncountyga.gov/dhw-immunizations/3708-immunization-clinic-locations-and-hours>. The State of Georgia requires up-to-date or completed immunizations for school attendance. All students entering school must be immunized according to the rules and regulations established by Georgia Department of Human Resources (DHR), and have an updated Immunization Certificate #3231 on file unless one of the following situations exist:

*Medical Exemption authorized by a medical doctor attached to the 3231 certificates (to be reviewed and renewed annually)

*Religious Exemption – Form 2208 Affidavit of Religious Objection to Immunization
