WHEN: **Friday, March 6th**
TIME: **Please arrive before the 10:00 am start time. (Finished around noon)**
WHERE: 6601 Bay Circle, Norcross, GA 30071 (use Google Maps)
WHAT: Learn more about the Program, submit an application and have a real job interview with one of our contractors.

Consider bringing but NOT REQUIRED to attend:

1. Valid Picture ID
2. Copy of your Birth Certificate
3. Copy of High School Diploma or GED (seniors provide by **June 15th**)
4. Application Fee - \$45 check, money order or debit card payable to AEJATC -- **(no cash)**. **Due by May 15th**

The process will begin once we have all the above paperwork. You must pass a national standardized aptitude test containing Algebra 1, a little Trig and 10th grade reading/comprehension. We will be passing out sample test questions during our CAREER DAY. Actual test not given until June or July.
