

Am I Ready for 1st Grade?

Necessary skills for rising kindergarteners



ELA	Math
Print uppercase and lowercase letters	Count to 100 by ones and by tens.
Produce primary sounds of consonants and short vowels	Count forward beginning from a given number within the known sequence (instead of having to begin at 1).
Pronounce initial, middle, final sounds in CVC words	Count to answer 'how many?' questions
Know and apply grade-level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words	Identify whether the number of objects in one group is greater than, less than, or equal to the number of objects in another group
Recognize and produce rhyming words	Solve addition and subtraction word problems, and add and subtract within 10
Count, pronounce, blend, and segment syllables in spoken words	Decompose numbers less than or equal to 10 into pairs in more than one way
Read common high-frequency words by sight.	For any number from 1 to 9, find the number that makes 10 when added to the given number
Retell Stories B-M-E	Compose and decompose numbers from 11 to 19 into ten ones and some further ones
Identify characters, setting, events from a story	Describe objects in the environment using names of shapes, and describe the relative positions of these objects using terms such as above, below, beside, in front of, behind, and next to
Identify main topic and key ideas of text that is read aloud	Identify, analyze and compare two- and three-dimensional shapes, in different sizes and orientations
Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to narrate a single event or several loosely linked events, tell about the events in the order in which they occurred, and provide a reaction to what happened.	Fluently add/subtract within 5.
Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English capitalization, punctuation, spacing and inventive spelling when writing	

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
