Reminder that tomorrow, Tuesday, January 26th, all 9th, 10th and 11th grade students are invited to come to AHS and take the PSAT. This is a wonderful opportunity that our district provides for all our students but please know that the PSAT is not mandatory. For students who will take the PSAT assessment tomorrow, please arrive to campus and go to the cafeteria. At 8:15am, all students will be released to go to their testing room. Over the weekend, all students were e-mailed their testing location and proctor's name. Students should arrive to campus knowing their testing location. If tomorrow will be your first day on campus this semester, please remember you must wear a mask and should bring your own bottle of water. We also recommend you have your own personal hand sanitizer.

Students should eat a healthy breakfast tomorrow morning, bring 2 sharpened #2 pencils and bring an approved calculator to use on one of the math sections of the PSAT. Please access today's morning message transcript for a link to college board with approved calculators.
