Good Afternoon Raiders,

We are now one week away from officially kicking off the 2020-2021 School Year!

This is an important update regarding Information Day this Thursday, Textbook Drop Off this week and the process for requesting any necessary schedule change requests.

AHS Information Day will be held on Thursday, August 13<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm. This year, Information Day is primarily designed for our students to have a test run of accessing each of their AHS classes and teachers through Microsoft Teams. We need all AHS students to access their teacher's classes between 1pm and 4pm on Thursday using Class Link. Detailed instructions will be posted to our AHS website as well as e-mailed to parents and students by tomorrow morning. We need to be able to troubleshoot any access obstacles prior to Monday so your student's cooperation in this test run Thursday is highly appreciated. Please remember that every day we need our students turning on their FCS device for at least 30 minutes in order to receive important Microsoft updates.

We will also host our AHS textbook drop off this week. Seniors will be on Wednesday, Juniors on Thursday and Sophomores on Friday. The drop off time will be based on student grade level and last name in order to manage traffic flow and safety. Specific details will be posted to our AHS website as well as e-mailed to parents and students by tomorrow morning.

Finally, we understand that students may have a need to make a request for necessary schedule changes. We have a process for this that entails completing an electronic form after carefully reading our schedule change guidelines. That electronic form will be posted to our AHS website as well as e-mailed to parents and students by tomorrow morning.
