Grading Categories

Students' grades are determined by the following categories:

<u>Major</u>: An assignment or assessment that is cumulative in nature that measures learning targets from multiple standards/skills.

Minor: An assignment or assessment that measures an individual learning target, standard, or subset of learning targets/standards/skills within a unit.

<u>Practice:</u> Daily assignments, observations, and/or engagement activities given in class or for homework to build pre-requisite skills, measure
Progress towards mastery of a learning target or standard, enrich, and/or

Remediate skills.
