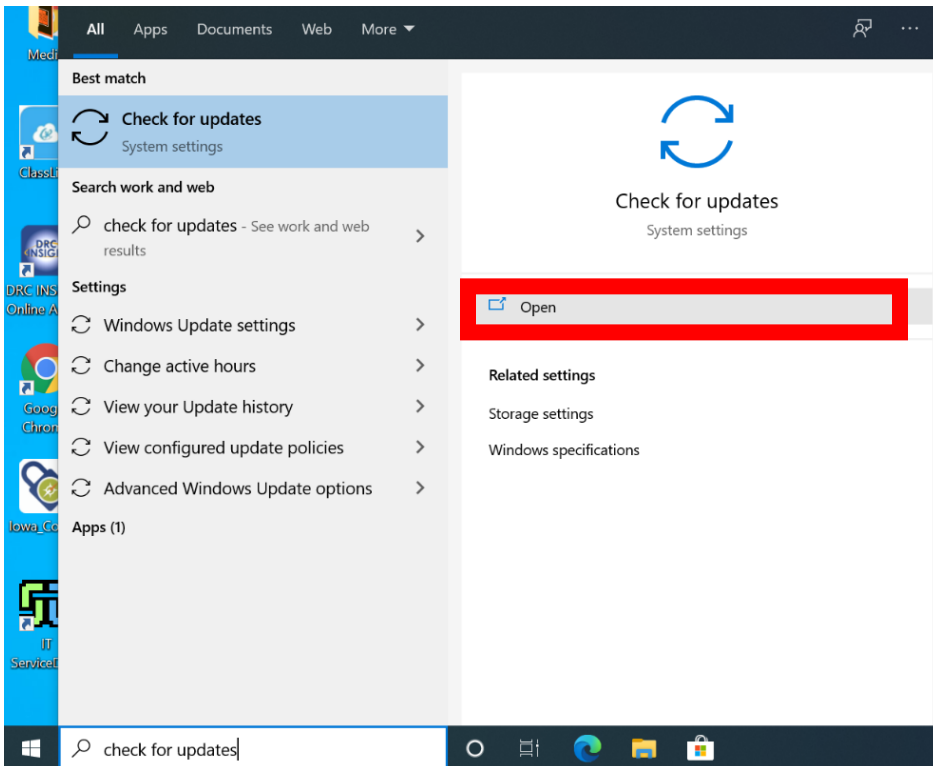
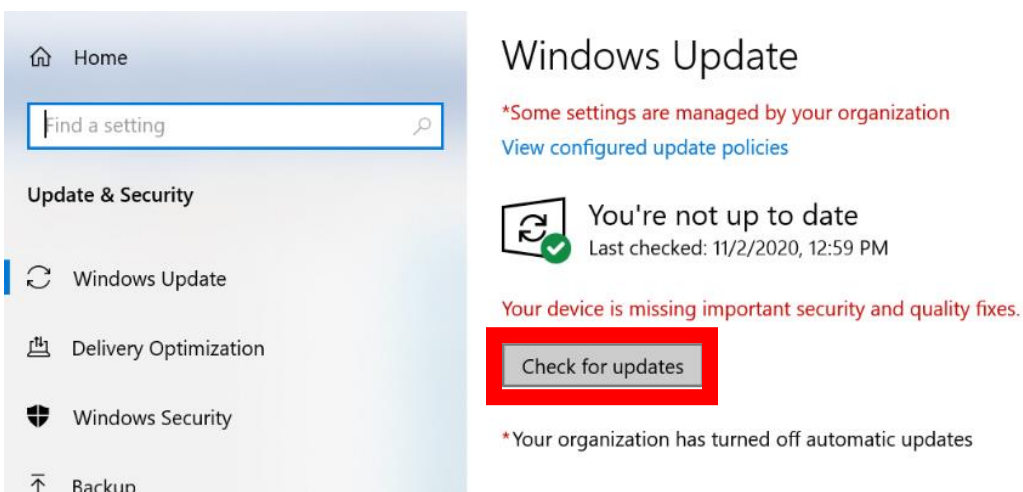


Device Update

1. In the search bar, type “check for updates”.
2. Select “open”.



3. Select the “check for updates” button.



4. If your device needs updates, they will automatically start downloading once you select “check for updates”. **To make updates run faster, plug your device into a power source.** This is what it may look like while the updates are running:

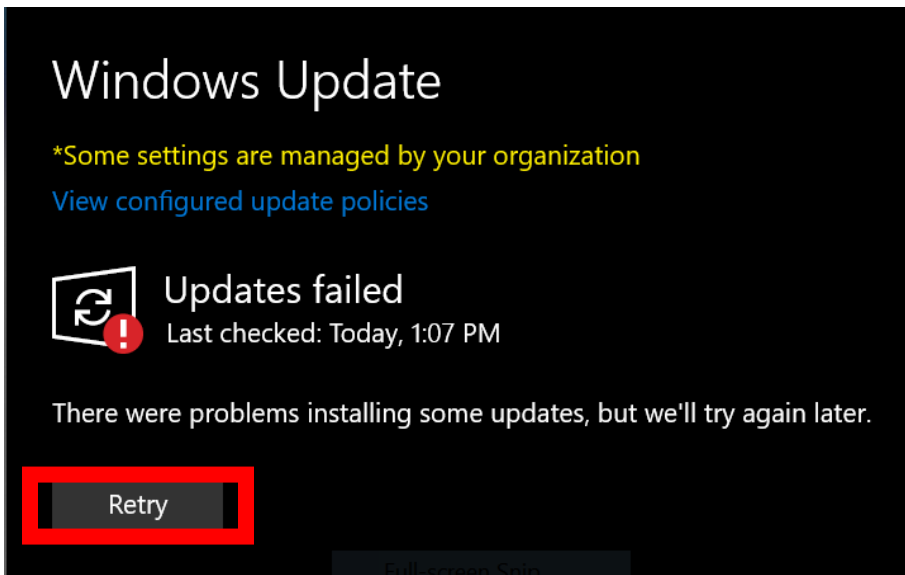

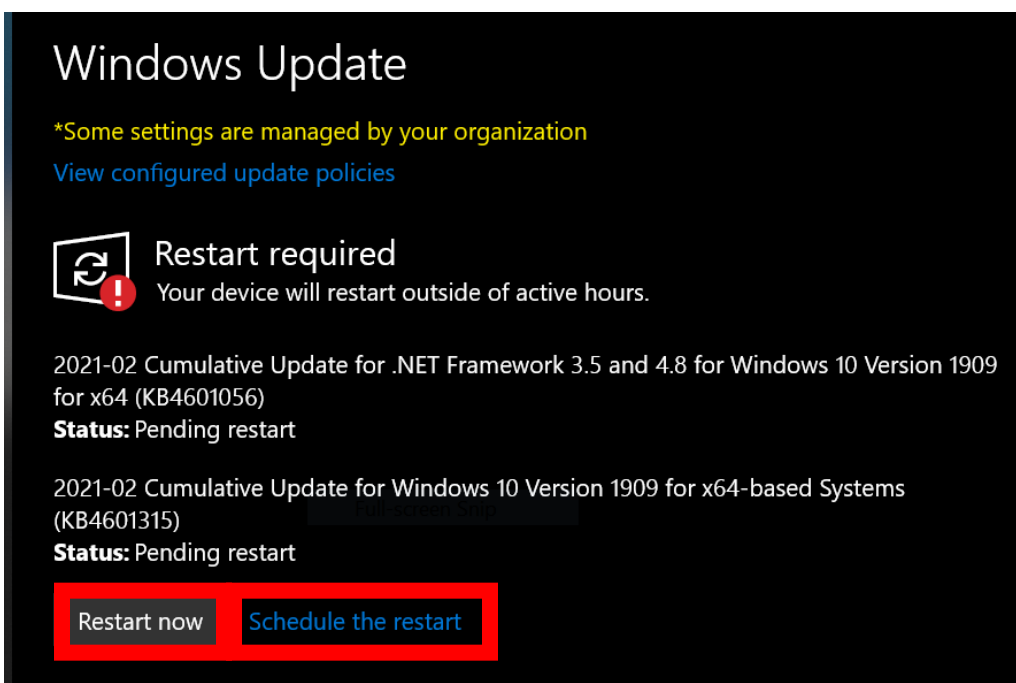
