Students will identify sol mi patterns on a staff.

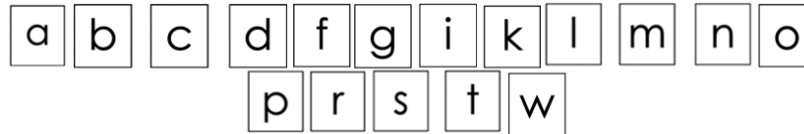
