Today marks the beginning of Fulton County Schools Reopening Phase III. We are so excited to welcome our PK – Fifth grade students back into the building for face-to-face(F2F) instruction! To keep our students and staff healthy and safe, we want to share a few reminders and updates:

1. Students in grades PK-5 are scheduled to attend one full day (1 day per week).
2. Students will attend face-to-face instruction during Phase III based on household last names:
 - *Monday (Group 1) – A through E*
 - *Tuesday (Group 2) – F through K*
 - *Thursday (Group 3) – L through P*
 - *Friday (Group 4) – Q through Z*
3. As Fulton County Schools moves through a cautious and measured phased approach to face-to-face(F2F)instruction, parents will have the option to remain in Universal Remote Learning (URL). A survey is now available where each student's preference for F2F and URL for each phase may be selected. You may also select your preference for your child's learning for the return to full time F2F learning after October 14, 2020, which will be for the remainder of the semester.  - Please have your student's ID number (this is the same as their lunch number)
 - You will have a choice for in-person or remote learning for each phase
 - If you have multiple students, you will need to enter your choice for each child seperately.
4. Due to safety concerns, device distribution for students in grades 2-5 and learning bundles for all students will be distributed on Wednesday 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM. Additional times are available by appointment only. If you need to schedule an appointment, please call the school at (470)254-3092. Bins for learning bundle drop-off are available in the car loop lane Monday-Friday 8 AM – 4 PM.
5. Students will be expected to wear a face-covering/mask while at school. Staff is also required to wear face coverings.
6. If your child is sick, please keep them at home and make sure they are fever-free for at least 24 hours before return.
7. If anyone in your household has tested positive for COVID-19 and you have been advised to isolate or quarantine, please adhere to the public health guidance and do not send your student to school until after the noted timeframe.
8. Encourage your student to wash hands frequently.
9. If your child becomes sick while at school, you will be expected to pick-up your child immediately.
10. Please alert the school administration of any COVID-19 related concerns.
11. Fulton County Schools has developed protocols and procedures to respond to COVID-19 related cases and concerns. The district will continue to work in collaboration with our local and state public health officials and follow the appropriate guidance.
