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World Language Expectations

Students that are successful in World Language are

- Self starters
- Independent Learners (know how to make and manage a daily study plan at home)
- Willing to participate daily
- Willing to take risks and step out of their comfort zone
- Independent with organizational skills (need to be able to manage and maintain a notebook instead of a textbook)

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World Languages Options
ASL, Chinese, French, Spanish.

- 6th grade World Language Class is an introductory class.
- 7th and 8th grade courses combined earn one High School Level 1 credit.
