

18f.II Prohibited Use of Personal Communication Devices (PCD) During School Day

Possession of Personal Communication Devices (PCD) (e.g., cell phones, tablets, recording devices) by a student at school during school hours is a privilege that will be forfeited if a student fails to abide by the Student Code of Conduct.

- The use of PCDs during the school day is not allowed in grades Pre-K through 5.
- In grades 6 through 12, the use of PCDs is not allowed during instructional time and will only be allowed when explicitly instructed to do so by a teacher or other school staff member

CELL PHONE POLICY

- Using phones to record/share inappropriate content will result in severe consequences.
- Failure to follow this policy will result in consequences JUST AS SEVERE AS THE INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT, including detention, ISS, OSS and mandatory parent meetings.


18g.III Inappropriate Recording and Distribution Using Personal Communication Devices (PCD)

The use of cell phones and other PCDs for noneducational purposes, including but not limited to, recording staff and/or students without permission or other inappropriate content is strictly prohibited. In addition, using a cell phone or other personal communication device to record a fight, battery, or any other inappropriate content and either sharing with others (e.g., airdrop, nearby share, SharelT, etc.) and/or uploading the video to any other type of social media/web- based media is also strictly prohibited.

Consequences for doing so may result in up to a 10 Day suspension and a referral for a discipline hearing with a recommendation for long term suspension.

- Rule #1 Student Professionalism


- Rule #5 No Sagging Clothing

TARDIES & 10/10 Rule

SCHOOL SAFETY

- School Safety is of utmost importance
 - All students must use MAIN ENTRANCE (Gym during PM Dismissal)
 - Opening/Propping Doors (Automatic Suspension)
 - Identification of self (Automatic Suspension)
 - Under the influence (Automatic Suspension)

HALL PASSES/OUT OF AREA/SKIPPING

- Students should have a hall pass AT ALL TIMES if not with a teacher or in your classroom. NOT DURING CREW.
- Students out of the classroom without a pass are <u>OUT OF</u>
 AREA and will be escorted to ISS.
- Students who take excessive time to return to class ("sick" in the restroom, "checking" on someone, "going to get my charger") are SKIPPING
 - Legitimate concerns should go to appropriate location (Clinic, Counseling Office, Administrator's Office)
- WBL/Mentors/Senior Reduced Schedule
 - Must have PRIORITY PASS
- Follow Procedures = No problems
