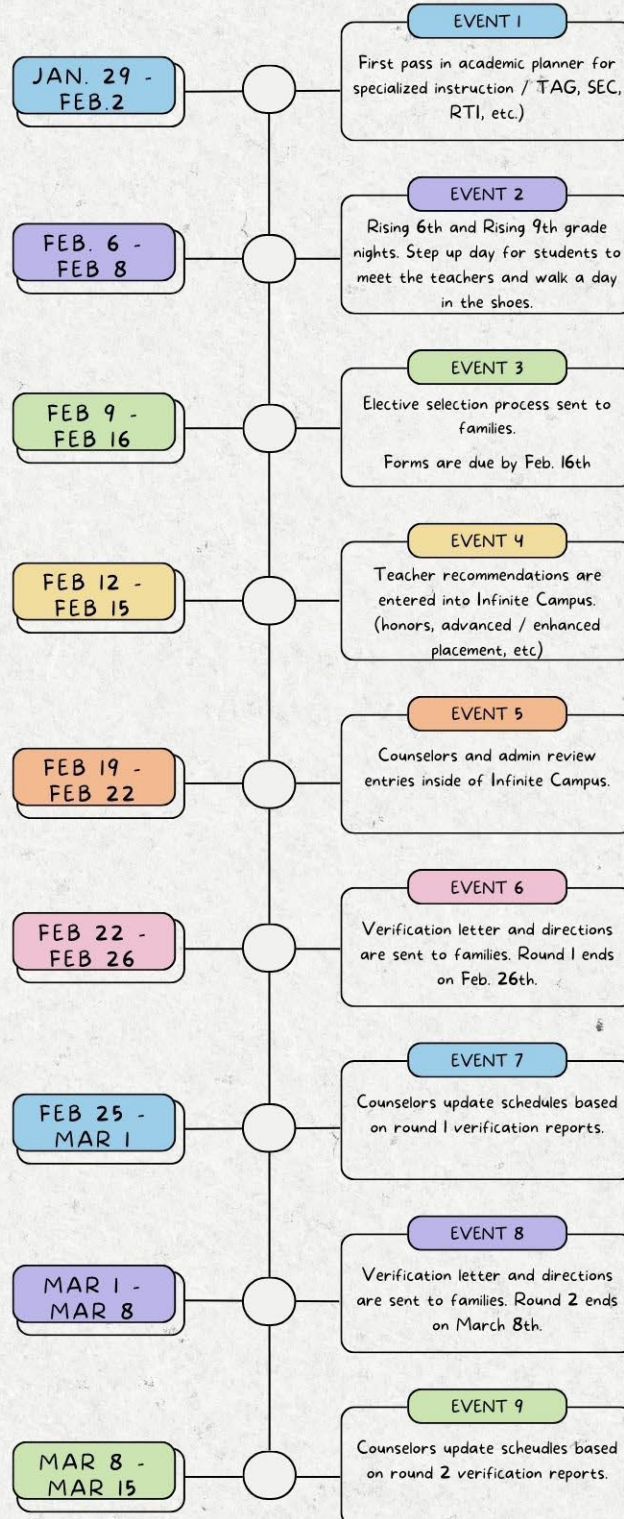

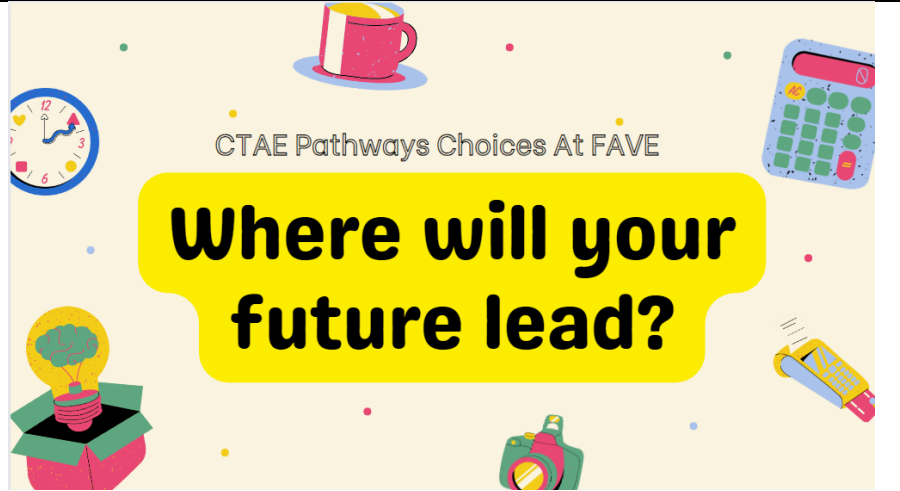
Electives Selection Form
