## Key Highlights of Testing Information:

- We are asking ALL families to please respond to the survey that was sent out via messenger **by Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021**, so that we can adequately prepare for testing administration.
- ALL GA Milestones testing administration will occur in the morning time (**except for remote learners who select the alternate testing opportunity**).
- **Testing administration will begin on each testing day at 9:00 AM** and we anticipate that it will end at approximately 10:15 AM.
- The # of questions and the time allotted for testing has decreased this year; therefore, we will plan to begin our instructional day (at the conclusion of testing) around **10:15 AM each day of testing**.
- **Students will test with their HOMEROOM TEACHER** (with a few exceptions such as those who will be testing in small group with accommodations)
- At the conclusion of the testing period (**approximately 10:15 AM**) students will be dismissed from their testing room locations and will proceed to continue their instructional day and attend each of their regularly scheduled classes.
- **Remote Learners** may have the option to **1)** test with their group (FTF) during the regularly scheduled testing administration time for their group/grade level, **2)** test during the “alternate” testing administration times (listed on the calendar) or **3)** refuse testing and indicate this on the parent survey.
- **Face to Face Learners** will take the GA Milestones at the times indicated here **UNLESS** the parent indicated on the survey that they’ve refused testing for their student and/or notified the testing coordinator of their intent to opt-out of the testing administration.
- **Face to Face Learners** who are not testing will be housed in a separate location (the CMS café) during the testing session and will then report to their content area classes at the conclusion of testing each morning.
