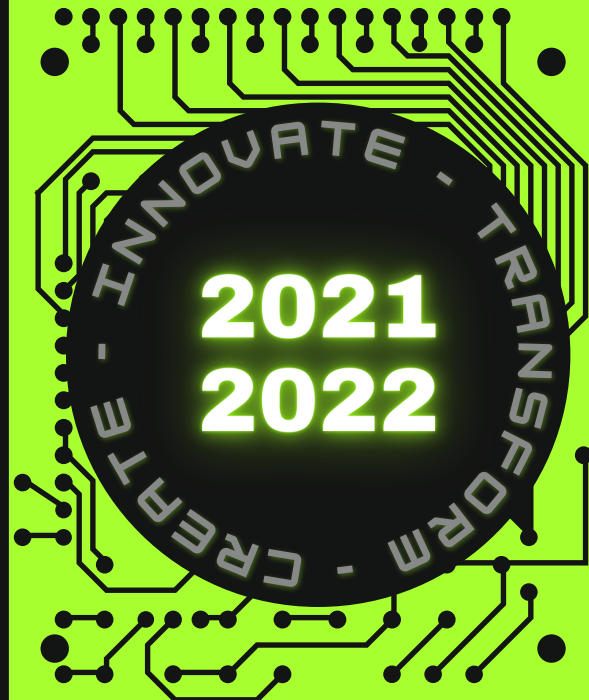




FULTON COUNTY TECHNOLOGY COMPETITION



What is the FCS Technology Competition?

The Fulton County Schools Technology Competition is regional competition for the Georgia Student Technology Competition. GaSTC is a statewide technology competition where students in grades 3-12 compete in a variety of technology categories with the main goal of challenging students to become leaders in a digital age.

Frequently Asked Questions

1 Who can compete?

All **3rd -12th grade** Fulton County students are invited to enter a student-created technology project that aligns with one of the 14 GaSTC categories.

2 How does it work?

Students may only enter ONE project into the competition that aligns to one of the 12 GaSTC categories.

Students may work individually or with a partner.

Projects are to be designed and created by students. Some adult guidance are allowed, but it must be clear that work entered by students was done by the students.

The competition will take place virtually and thus all projects must be submitted as a video presentation no matter the original project.

3 What is the timeline?

Mid-Late November: Student Registration Opens
December 6th - 16th: Students Submit Projects
January 17th - 28th: Judging Window
Before February 28th: Announce 1st Place Winners and report to the state
