

Executive Summary

GA Milestones Spring 2019 Administration

Students in Fulton County participated in GA Milestones End of Grade and End of Course assessments this spring as required by the Georgia Department of Education. Please note that while results for these assessments are included in the annual CCRPI (College and Career Readiness Performance Index) reports developed by the state, business rules used by the state for accountability are different from those used for public reporting of GA Milestones results. For instance, CCRPI only includes results for Full Academic Year students and may include credit for performance on other assessments such as the GAA and Dual Enrollment courses. CCRPI also includes results for all GA Milestones assessment administrations during the school year including retest and summer results. Results from retest, summer, and winter administrations are not included in the GA Milestones public release. Highlights from the GA Milestones 2019 Spring Administration are listed below.

End of Grade Assessments

- **Overall Highlights**
 - Student proficiency in the areas of English/Language Arts and Mathematics increased in all grades.
 - The percent of students scoring in Developing or above was above state and RESA results in all grades for English/Language Arts.
 - In Grade 3, 74 percent of students scored in Developing or Above for English/Language Arts, a five-percentage point gain from 2018.
 - The percent of students Reading At or Above Grade Level increased in all grades and continues to be above results for the state and RESA.
 - Students Reading At or Above Grade Level in Grade 3 improved to 76 percent in 2019, a six percentage point gain over 2018.
 - Performance for Grade 6 students scoring in the Developing and above categories in English/Language Arts increased to 80 percent, an eight-percentage point gain over 2018, while performance for Grade 8 students in the same area increased to 85 percent, a six-percentage point gain.
 - Grade 8 performance in the categories of Developing or above improved in all subject areas.

- **Grade 8 Highlights**

End of Course Assessments

- Results for students in Fulton exceeded the state in Ninth Grade Literature, American Literature, Algebra, Biology, Physical Science, U.S. History and Economics.
- The percentage of students scoring in the Developing or above category increased in Ninth Grade Literature, American Literature, Geometry, Physical Science, and U.S. History.
- Eighty-nine percent of students scored the Developing or above category in Ninth Grade Literature, a three-percentage point gain over 2018. In addition, the percent of students scoring as Proficient or above increased by 6 percentage points to 68 percent.
- Middle school students participated in over 4,300 End of Course assessments with an overall proficiency rate of 88 percent.
- Of the nearly 1,200 Grade 8 students that took Ninth Grade Literature End of Course assessments, 97 percent scored as Proficient or above.
- Over 1,600 Grade 8 students took the Algebra End of Course assessment with over 86 percent scoring as Proficient or above.
- Creekside HS, McClarin HS, and Tri-Cities HS posted double-digit gains in the percent of students scoring in the Developing or Above categories in Ninth Grade Literature.
- Six schools, including Alpharetta HS, Cambridge HS, Chattahoochee HS, Johns Creek HS, Milton HS, and Northview HS, had 95 percent or more students score in the Developing or above categories on the Ninth Grade Literature assessment.
- Alpharetta HS, Cambridge HS, Chattahoochee HS, and Northview HS had 95 percent or more students in the Developing or above category on the American Literature assessment.
