

Greetings Families,

Thank you for your continued support with the Fulton County FoodStop Meal Distribution. Fulton County School Nutrition will continue to serve nutritious and safe meals to all enrolled FCS students while schools are virtual.

Beginning Wednesday, August 26, 2020, Fulton County School Nutrition and the Transportation Department will begin offering The Mobile FoodStop at designated South Cluster bus stops for enrolled Fulton students.

Bus Stop Locations:

<p>Phoenix Place 2420 Heaton Drive East Point, GA 30344</p>
<p>Diplomat at Harrington Apartments <i>(or known as Crystal at Camp Creek)</i> 2700 Camp Creek Parkway Atlanta, GA 30337</p>
<p>Embarcadero Club Apartments <i>Bus will be parked in the area across from the leasing office</i> 2210 Sullivan Road College Park, GA 30337</p>
<p>Chelsea Garden Apartments <i>Bus will be parked along the cul-de-sac</i> 2135 Godby Road College Park, GA 30349</p>

- The Mobile FoodStop is for enrolled Fulton County School students ONLY.
- The Mobile FoodStop will deliver meal kits to assigned bus stops on Wednesdays.
- Enrolled Fulton County students will need to arrive at the bus stop locations between 10:45 – 12:00 to receive a meal kit.
- Find the closest bus stop to your home and have someone be present at the delivery time.
- Student Meal Barcodes will be utilized to receive a meal kit.
- The student does not need to be present to receive the meal kit, but the parent/sibling picking up the student meal must show the Student Meal Barcode to get meals.
- Due to the size of the packages, please bring something with you to help you carry the meal kits home.

The FCS FoodStop drive-thru model will continue to be utilized to distribute weekly meals. The FCS FoodStop provides an opportunity for families to drive-up and pick up Grab & Go meal kits for FCS students. To maximize social distancing, drivers are not to leave their vehicles; however, walk-ups are allowed. **FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Sites will be open on Wednesdays from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.**

Each FoodStop Meal Distribution Site will only serve students from specific feeder schools. Students that attend Asa G. Hilliard Elementary School, College Park Elementary School, and/or Woodland Middle School can pick-up meal kits from Asa G. Hilliard Elementary School.

The Mobile FoodStop will serve as another option to receive meal kits. Families may pick-up meals at the FoodStop Meal Distribution Site OR at the bus stop locations.

Students enrolled at Asa G. Hilliard Elementary School, College Park Elementary School, and Woodland Middle School can get a healthy school breakfast & lunch for FREE during the school year. These schools qualify for the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) as part of USDA's National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program. Families do not have to fill out meal applications for children enrolled in the below schools.

At FCS The Mobile FoodStop bus stop locations, meal kits will be accounted for using Student Meal Barcodes, a no-contact cashiering method.

- **To get started, visit <https://nutrition.fultonschools.org/BarCode> to receive your Student Meal Barcode.**
 1. In the "Student Number" box, enter your 10-digit student ID and hit "Get Barcode". This will generate your Student Meal Barcode.
 2. Print or screenshot the barcode for future use.
 3. You will need to do this for all students in your household.

We appreciate your assistance and will coordinate this effort as efficiently as possible, but our goal remains to feed the students while keeping potential exposure to the community as limited as possible.
