### CLASS PERIODS

Johns Creek operates under a seven period day. Students are enrolled in six courses for the year (lunch is a scheduled period). Exceptions include offerings which are semester courses. Classes meet 53 minutes per day. Credit is awarded every 18 weeks (0.5 credits per course) with a maximum of 6 credits earned during the regular school year.

#### ATHLETIC MILESTONES

Football won its 3<sup>rd</sup> Region Championship in 4 years. Also won its first ever playoff game and was ranked in the top 10.

Girls Cross Country finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Region and 4<sup>th</sup> in AAAAAAA GHSA State Championships.

Girls Basketball won its 1<sup>st</sup> Region Championship and advanced to the Elite 8 of AAAAAA GHSA State Playoffs.

Boys Basketball placed 4<sup>th</sup> in Region and advanced to AAAAAA GHSA State Playoffs.
