

Fulton County Schools Back-to-School FoodStop Meal Distribution

Fulton County, GA - The first day of school may be different this year, but Fulton County School Nutrition will continue to serve nutritious & safe meals to all enrolled FCS students while schools are virtual.

When Universal Remote Learning was announced the Fulton County School Nutrition Program knew one of the top priorities included continuing to provide nutritious meals for all FCS students. The district began working on a food distribution plan for families to pick-up meals at centrally located school sites throughout the district.

The FCS FoodStop drive-thru model will be utilized to distribute weekly meals at 22 school sites throughout the district. The FCS FoodStop provides an opportunity for families to drive-up and pick up Grab & Go meal kits for students. To maximize social distancing, drivers are not to leave their vehicles; however, walk-ups are allowed.

Each FoodStop Meal Distribution Site will only serve students from specific feeder schools.

The first day for meal kit pick-up is Friday, August 14, 2020. During this special distribution day, FCS students will receive enough meals to last until the first official distribution on Wednesday, August 19, 2020. FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Sites will be open on Wednesdays from 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

The cost of the meal kits will include five breakfast meals and five lunch meals.

Our FoodStop Meal Distribution Sites allow communities to continue feeding children while school is remote.”

FoodStop sites will remain contactless during food distribution. Families are asked to prepay for student meals online, complete Free & Reduced Meal applications online, and utilize Student Meal Barcodes at FCS Foodstops.

Everything you need to know about student meals for the first day of school!

Have you completed a Free & Reduced Meal Application for the 2020-2021 school year?

Did you know free & reduced-price meal applications benefit your family and your school?! Families may qualify for free or reduced-price school breakfast & lunch.

The Free & Reduced Meal Benefits Program is a part of the National Child Nutrition Program. This program makes Free or Reduced priced meals available to qualifying households. Qualifications are based on the gross income of all household members and the number of persons living in the house.

A new application must be completed every school year. If there is an interruption in benefits or the household does not reapply, the household is responsible for payment of meals until the Free and Reduced Application is approved.

Have you added money to your student's meal account?

Fulton County Schools offer healthy meals with all five food groups at a reasonable price. Prices cover food and operational expenses to prepare the food.

- The cost of each meal kit will include 10 meals - 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches - to feed students until the next meal kit distribution. Pricing is based on the meal benefits a student qualifies (free, reduced, or paid).

- Pay for student meals online using MyPaymentsPlus.
 1. MyPaymentsPlus can be accessed via the web or the MyPaymentsPlus mobile app.
 2. Open the application or visit www.mypaymentsplus.com and click on the “Register Now” button.
 3. Select “Georgia” as your state and “Fulton County Schools” as your school district.
 4. Enter your parent/guardian information, along with your email and a password for the account.
 5. After the initial registration, follow the onscreen directions and register your student(s) using their student 10-digit ID number(s).
 - The Student ID number is the Permanent Number (Permnum) in SASI. This is the number that is assigned to each student and goes with them from school to school. It is the number that is on the student's schedule, report card, etc. It is not the Georgia Testing or Social Security number.

To keep FoodStop sites contactless, cash or checks will not be accepted during meal distribution.

Have you gotten your Student Meal Barcode?

At FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Sites, meal kits will be accounted for using Student Meal Barcodes, a no-contact cashiering method.

- To get started, visit <https://nutrition.fultonschools.org/BarCode> to receive your Student Meal Barcode.
 1. In the “Student Number” box, enter your 10-digit student ID and hit “Get Barcode”. This will generate your Student Meal Barcode.
 2. Print or screenshot the barcode for future use.
 3. You will need to do this for all students in your household.

What are FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Sites?

FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Sites provides an opportunity for families to drive-up and pick up Grab & Go meal kits for all enrolled FCS students. To maximize social distancing, drivers are not to leave their vehicles; however, walk-ups are allowed. The sites will distribute weekly meal kits at 22 school sites throughout the district. Each meal kit will contain 10 meals - 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches - to feed students until the next meal kit distribution. Meal kits will include items that can be reheated at home. Meal safety, reheating instructions, and a menu will be provided in meal kits. Each FoodStop location will only service students from specific feeder schools.

All Fulton County Schools have been assigned to a specific FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Site. Based on the school a student is enrolled at, families are to visit that assigned FoodStop site.

□ What to do at an FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Site:

1. Arrive at your assigned FoodStop Meal Distribution Site on Wednesday between 11:00 am & 1:00 pm.
2. To maximize social distancing, drivers are not to leave their vehicles; however, walk-ups are allowed.
3. Once in line at the FoodStop, get your Student Meal Barcode(s) pulled up on your phone or have the printed version readily available.
4. When at the front of the line, display your Student Meal Barcode(s) to the School Nutrition Employee. The School Nutrition Employee will scan your Student Meal Barcode(s) to ring up the student meal kit(s). This will charge the student's meal account.
5. School Nutrition Employees will then gather the meal kit(s) for your student(s). Meal kits will contain 10 meals - 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches.
6. To maximize social distancing, School Nutrition Employees have been instructed to place meal kits in the trunk of cars.
 - Make sure to unlock and open trunks.
 - Please make sure there is room in the trunk. If the trunk is full, you will be asked to pull over and make room for the meals and then return to the drive-thru.
7. Once all meal kits are placed in the trunk, a School Nutrition Employee will close the trunk and you may safely drive away.
 - All meal kits will include items that can be reheated at home. Meal safety, reheating instructions, and a menu will be provided in meal kits.
 - Wash hands with soap and water before handling food.
 - Perishable (cold) food that is not eaten immediately upon delivery should be refrigerated as soon as possible.
 - Discard any perishable (cold) that is not eaten or refrigerated within 2 hours of delivery.
8. FoodStop Meal Distribution will continue every Wednesday.
