

## Georgia Milestones 2022

Students in Fulton County participated in Georgia Milestones Assessment System (GMAS) End of Grade and End of Course assessments this spring as required by the Georgia Department of Education. The annual CCRPI (College and Career Readiness Performance Index) reports developed by the state will include results for these assessments. The business rules used by the state for CCRPI differ from those used for public reporting of spring GA Milestones results. For instance, CCRPI only includes results for Full Academic Year students and may include credit for performance on other assessments such as the GAA, Dual Enrollment, and AP courses. CCRPI also contains results for all GA Milestones assessment administrations during the school year, including summer results. GMAS public release does not include summer and winter administration results.

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**Achievement Levels refer to a range of scores that define a specific level of achievement. There are four achievement levels.**

- **Distinguished Learner** - Students demonstrate advanced proficiency in the knowledge and skills necessary at this grade level/course.
- **Proficient Learner** - Students demonstrate proficiency in the knowledge and skills necessary at this grade level/course.
- **Developing Learner** - Students demonstrate partial proficiency in the knowledge and skills necessary at this grade level/course.
- **Beginning Learner** - Students do not yet demonstrate proficiency in the knowledge and skills necessary at this grade level/course.

### Reading Status

- Reading Status is reported as either on/above Grade Level or Below Grade Level.
- Reading status is reported based on a subset of reading items

### Norm-Referenced Performance

- GA Milestones assessments include 20 test items from the TerraNova, a national norm-referenced test.
- These items are a sample and allow students to receive a national percentile score.
- The Median National Percentile is the score provided.
- The median national percentile is the score that divides the distribution of students in half.
- The median national percentile for the nation is 50 - half of the students score above 50 and half below 50.

For example, a student who scores a 65 percentile scores the same or better than 65% of the national norming group. This score can provide a general indicator or barometer of student performance relative to their national peers. Because this is a sample of items and not a full norm-referenced test, this score may not be used for gifted program identification.
