## School board approves school calendars, social studies curriculum, STEM campus name, and school allotments at January 17 meeting

The Fulton County Board of Education approved several agenda items at its January 17 meeting at the district’s South Learning Center. The board adopted calendars for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years, selected social studies resources for review, approved the name of the new STEM campus, and approved FY2019 mid-year adjustments and FY2020 school allotments.

Feedback collected at these sites will be used to make recommendations to the Fulton County School Board. The selected materials will go into effect during the 2019-2020 school year.

### **North Fulton STEM Campus Named**

The board approved the name of the new STEM campus, located in Milton, Georgia. It will now be known as Innovation Academy.

### **FY2019 Mid-year Budget Adjustments**

After a review of the projected General Fund revenues through the remainder of FY2019, a revenue adjustment was proposed and approved based on the expected decrease to local revenue. Also, there are adjustments stemming from an increase to state revenue for QBE earnings, and other revenue from interest earned on investments, proceeds from sale of land, and E-rate program reimbursement. The most significant expenditure adjustment provided a 2% salary increase to teachers on steps 4 to 14 of the Teachers Salary Schedule as approved by the Board in the FY2019 budget.

### **FY2020 School Allotment Formulas and Guidelines**

Additionally, the board also approved maintaining elementary, middle and high school class size at the current ratio, with the exception of remedial programs. The board also recommended changes to the alternative education program models at McClarin and Independence high schools. For additional information see BoardDocs.
