CCRPT:

“Everything that counts can be counted; not everything that can be counted counts.”
....86.67% makes up CCRPI (milestones) – not perfect measure; use to assess schools at a state level.not orange to orange. 2015-2018: content mastery, readiness, progress, closing gaps (the most change!!) 30 ...20... still worth 50 points

Progress now 35 points, closing gaps 15. ...HMS had 15

Challenge points – not available to us now ...PBIS, etc, 4 main categories and small pieces inside categories & that where we focus ...**students must grow**

Content Mastery - 1-4 on Milestones ...parents can opt out which affects participation rates; that lowers score even if students are doing well.

Motivation of students – alternate final exam; have discussions with students about the importance of Milestones

The “**closing the gap**” category is the most significant because it targets at-risk students. HMS did well in that category in 2017-2018

LeMoyne stressed that STUDENTS MUST GROW & if we are succeeding with at-risk students, we will be successful overall.

Note: Every student has an SGP – put by state into academic peer groups (ELA & Math)
Lexil targets went up
