7:43 am	<p>Informational Item: Principal’s Update</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Dates for budget meetings soon School budget 2019-’20 will be difficult – lower tax revenue: each student currently gets \$175 which is being reduced by \$27; in addition, we’re projected to be 60-65 students less next school year (\$50,000 less) Funding changing Re: remedial class size will help – class size can increase to 22-25 and school still receive funding ...rewarding financially for smaller class size HMS good job spending flex funds – now we can carry over flex funds until next year – we didn’t know that; 5% cost center budget but this year we can carry over 10%. – this will relieve some pressure in 2019-’20 ELL – a change here; budget targeted for these students should be taken from the ELL fund - avoid the political ramifications Feb – bigger budget meeting – looking at cutting back – Fiorito to head this Hoops for Heart – event is Valentine’s Day – 50% AMA and 50% to Lovin’ Everyday Foundation in honor of Matthew James LeMoyne Milestone testing – April 15 (8th) – test for 2 weeks ELA 3 days and math was split into 2 days ...5 days for ELA and math; tests are not longer, just spreading them out. About 90 minutes per day of testing followed by regular classes; after Milestones - a week for EOC testing; then the following week the 6th & 7th will take math and ELA Milestones.
