### Actions Items for Approval-

### Student Leadership Summit Recap led by Fryda Cortes and Nina Giddens-

-An external presenter from Giving Point is interested in partnering with WHS to facilitate workshops that are student driven. Presenter is interested in coming to the next SGC meeting to discuss the Social Innovators Academy program and how it can benefit WHS. Giving Point is asking for a meeting space and students interested in creating social change.

-Potential Clubs to involve with initiative: Going Against the Grain, FBLA, TSA, NHS, Gay/Straight alliance

-Student representative from Creekside HS provided insight on soliciting input from students on how to improve school programs and evaluate/learn about school goals to determine the student's role in affecting change. WHS may consider using advisement time to create this.

### WHS Principal Updates & RFF Renewals/Proposal-

Current CCRPI score is 79.7

Content Mastery-65.2 (currently behind the district and state)

Closing the Gaps-75.0

Progress-93.1

Readiness-73.0

School Climate-89.4

The metrics changed for this year so the data is not comparable to previous years due to a change in how 8<sup>th</sup> grade students taking 9<sup>th</sup> grade courses count toward high school scores.

-The Council could consider creating a RFF proposal to require that all WHS students complete three years of a foreign language which will align with our MYP program as well as pathway completion which has a direct impact on our CCRPI score.

-Student may still be able to have some pathway choice and meet their foreign language requirement. However, once a student begins to fail a course it will eliminate choice in scheduling options.

-We are awaiting school board approval to finalize the FCS calendar before a selection of RFF days can go forward.

-Mr. Robinson presented our student representatives with an award recognizing them for their service with the Student Leadership Summit.

#### SGC Website Audit Review Feedback (Corrections due Dec. 14<sup>th</sup>)

-The district will provide us with a progress monitoring tool to effectively measure our outcomes relative to our strategic plan.

-The monitoring tool must be updated and uploaded no later than February 14<sup>th</sup>. The district will be looking for progress and compliance on Clarity, Culture, and Communication

-Once the monitoring tool has been submitted, WHS will be given a score card based on our pillars and our effectiveness as an SGC.

-A committee chair is still needed for our communications and outreach committee.

#### Set Next Meeting Agenda:

-Once Mr. Robinson writes the proposal for new RFF initiatives, we can vote as an SGC council and make the notice public to our stakeholders.

-A special meeting may need to be called to allow for a vote on RFF proposal and allow for time for 30 day public comment from our stakeholders. This will be pending on how soon Mr. Robinson can write the proposal.
