

## SGC December Meeting Minutes

12/13/2022

Attendees: Ms. A. Dallas, Ms. Robinson, Dr. Brown, Mr. Burney, Ms. Tucker, Dr. S. Hall, Ms. Kemp.

- The meeting began at 2:15 p.m. Mrs. Dallas motion to call the meeting to order, Mr. Burney second. Motion carried.
- Dr. Hall read November minutes. Ms. Dallas motion to accept minutes as read. Ms. Tucker second. Motion carried.
- In accordance with the agenda, Mrs. Dallas briefly discussed Spring events. She stated the Poetry Slam and Father/Daughter Dance had been shared with PTA and are both expected to occur as discussed.
- As per waiting for Dr. Brown's Principal's update (due to an emergency phone call), Ms. Dallas shared that most of the items on the agenda had been previously addressed such as Safety Funds/Charter Dollars and referred council back to previously read November minutes. She also informed Council that Safety Funds and Charter Dollar Funds were being spent in the areas where SGC allotted the funds to be used. Action plans were also previously discussed in November. Mrs. Dallas reviewed the SGC Agenda additional note section which stated in January there would be a vote on the budget and additional items from the G & F Teams
- Principal's Update:

Dr. Brown spoke about teachers doing a phenomenal job in teaching & learning. She talked about Discipline heading in the downward direction.
- She said planning for 2023-2024 school budget had begun. Additionally, new data regarding performance on Science and Social Studies Assessments as well as IReady Diagnostics' ELA and Math Assessment was available and would updates would be shared in January's meeting.

- Dr. Brown discussed Woodland's Spelling Bee hosted on 12/13/2022. The Bee was approximately 12 rounds resulting in a winner who will represent WMS as the winning contestant.
- Dr. Brown thanked all SGC members and wished everyone a Happy Holiday season.
