

SGC November Meeting Minutes

11/18/2022

Attendees: Ms. A. Dallas, Ms. Robinson, Dr. Brown, Mr. Burney, Ms. Creshonna Tucker, Dr. S. Hall, Ms. Kemp.

- At 2:17 p.m. Mrs. Dallas motion to call the meeting to order, Dr. Hall second. Motion carried.
- Dr. Hall read October minutes. Ms. Dallas motion to accept minutes as read. Mr. Burney second. Motion carried.
- In accordance with the agenda, discussion ensued about potential future event suggestions for Woodland in 2022-2023.

Mrs. Dallas completed a recap of the Fall Cross Council PowerPoint and said Ms. Tucker will take the lead on this project for 2022-2023. Mrs. Dallas stated the PowerPoint shown has been approved by Zone Superintendents and described as Council Development Online displaying information to assist with SGC Compliance for years 2021-2022 & 2022-2023. The information shown applies to all school levels (Elementary, Middle and High School). Mrs. Dallas stated the information was available online under School Governance Council.

- Mrs. Dallas deferred to Dr. Brown to address the Safety Funds and Charter Dollars. Dr. Brown stated Safety Funds were used for:
 1. Updating Signage
 2. Safety Kits (for all Teachers)
 3. Extra Radios (To be used on Field Trips)
- Dr. Brown said the Charter Dollars are being used for select students in the following programs:
 1. Extended Learning (offered Saturdays)
 2. High Dosage Program (offered on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday)
- Dr. Brown discussed how the Semester Plan has been progressing through:
 1. Three Big Rocks-Relationships and Routines, Tier 1 Instruction, and Intervention by
 2. Daily Data Checks

She spoke about great things happening at Woodland and suggested for parents to follow Woodland's Twitter handle to observe. Dr. Brown spoke about recently attending a celebration in honor of a Woodland student being selected for a \$10,000 scholarship. She was 1 out of 8 recipients selected from the district. She said this young lady was the Keynote Speaker and will complete a one-on-one interview to be displayed on Fulton School District's website soon.

Dr. Brown discussed Woodland's preparation of upcoming assessments.

Interim Assessments starting the 1st week of December. (November 30-December 9th)

1. Science (December 12th -13th) 8th grade
2. Social Studies December 15th-16th) 8th grade
3. Math Assessment (December 14th)
4. ELA Assessment (December 16th-17th)

Dr. Brown said after reviewing Units 1 & 2 Assessments taken last year around the same time they noticed students had doubled their numbers in Proficiency and Content.

Dr. Brown stated that Woodland was still experiencing Bus Transportation issues and shared that discussions were being had with the Zone Superintendent in this regard. She also gave a brief recap on the Fall Dance held on October 28th and informed Volleyball Season has ended. She thanked all members for attendance of SGC meeting.
