

SGC October Meeting Minutes

10/18/2022

Attendees: Ms. A. Dallas, Ms. Robinson, Dr. Brown, Mr. Burney, Ms. Creshonna, Dr. S. Hall, Ms. Tucker, Ms. Kemp.

- At 2:04 p.m. Mrs. Dallas motion to call the meeting to order, Ms. Robinson second.
- Dr. Hall read September minutes. Ms. Dallas motion to accept minutes as read. Ms. Robinson second.
- In accordance with the agenda, discussion ensued about potential future event suggestions for Woodland in 2022-2023.

Ms. Dallas suggested the Poetry slam returning in the Spring. Ms. Robinson mentioned Dads on Duty to show more of a male presence in the school for students. A parent suggested “Grandparent Day”. Ms. Dallas said she and was sure Mrs. Frank-Smith does this and we should reach out to her regarding this event.

Ms. Kemp suggested hosting a Father/Daughter Dance for a Valentine’s Day Celebration.

Ms. Tucker asked about soliciting can goods for a Thanksgiving Food Drive to assist school’s parents in need.

- Dr. Brown stated she agreed with all the suggestions and wanted to see the return of the Poetry Jam in the Spring as well as the Father/Daughter dance. Other events can be discussed as needed.
- In her Principal’s Update, Dr. Brown said her Instructional Leadership Team reviewed the 1st 45 days of school. As of October 4th, the team began breaking 90 days into 20-day cycles to celebrate Quick-wins. Woodland continues to build relationships. She said the administrative team had conducted 240 observations within the past 20 days. Allowing real-time feedback to the team. There had been an uptick on Board configuration and learning targets to 73%. Intentional monitoring showed Bell-to-Bell instruction, modeling learning.

Dr. Brown shared a short review of presentation shared with administrative team and stated the goals met and unmet, Social Studies met all goals in 1st 45 days, and Science Assessments had not been administered. Intervention Block was discussed and upcoming Mid-Year IReady Diagnostic.

- Ms. Kemp mentioned how parents could potentially assist with after-school tutoring in ELA/Math for 2 hours on Saturday mornings or for students hanging around after school.
- Dr. Brown spoke about offerings that may be able to assist parents with tutoring.
- Ms. Kemp mentioned the need for virtual tutoring and sending study guides home.

Dr. Brown reminded everyone of upcoming events. 7th grade MOP 10/19, 10/22.
