"Word of the Week" - Vocabulary development is a crucial component of an effective literacy program. Each week, we identify a new vocabulary word that we want our students to become more familiar with and be able to add to their repertoire. Our hope is that by exposing students to a different word every week, they can begin to "own" these words and make them a part of their working vocabulary! We encourage you to find ways to use this word in your conversations with your students whenever the opportunity presents itself!

News and Notes:

- If your student missed an exam this week, they can come to school on the 2nd from 9-noon or stay after school until 5:30 on Wednesday and/or Thursday (January 4th and 5th).
- New Electronic Pass System for Students When we return from break, we will begin utilizing a new system for issuing student passes. SmartPass is a system that allows us to track when and how often students use passes. It also allows us to set limits so only a pre-determined number of students can get a pass to the same place at the same time. It even allows us to keep combinations of students from being in the hallways at the same time if necessary. The system is accessed through Classlink and meets all privacy requirements for use in Fulton County Schools. We hope this will help us more effectively manage and monitor students throughout the day, with the ultimate goal of keeping them in class more!
