Hello HMS Families,

We have had a great first week and have truly enjoyed having your kids back at school! We ended today with a great "Mustang PRIDE Hype Day" to celebrate being back to school. Special thanks to our PRIDE Committee, PE staff, teachers, and our parent volunteers who helped with some of the logistics and planning for the day!

Every Friday, you will receive an email from me with important updates or news items, information about school or community activities, and reminders of important routines and procedures at HMS. <u>At a minimum, we ask that you skim it for any new or important information.</u> Along with this email, it is important to note that answers to many of your questions can be found on the HMS website and/or in the Student/Parent Handbook, which is under the Academics tab on the website!

Some things of note regarding processes and procedures:

- Dismissal the first several days is always a challenge, but we're getting there! Buses are getting better, but it does take some time for the routines to get established and the times to get more predictable. I appreciate your patience as things settle out!
- Afternoon carpool has gone surprisingly well, thanks to everyone who visited the website
 (<u>Carpool Procedures / Carpool Procedures (fultonschools.org</u>)) and read the directions before
 coming, and for the others, thanks for politely following the directions of the staff members
 outside.
- Just a heads up, we ask that you limit drop-offs of items to emergencies only. Make sure students have money on their lunch account that they can use if they forget their lunch, and if they forget a notebook or something like that, they can live without it for a day. We will not call students up to the front to pick up items, unless it is medication or some other emergency situation warrants it.
- HMS has an email specifically for sending in notes/excuses for student absences. You can email your parent, doctor, dentist, etc. note to HMSAttendance@fultonschools.org. This is not for early dismissal requests. These notes should be sent into the front office with your student in the morning on the day they need to leave early. You do not need to email individual teachers to notify them of an absence.
- When you have a need to communicate with staff, please follow the guidelines below:
 - o For specific classroom issues, email the teacher first
 - For general questions about how the day works, email the Advisement teacher
 - For general issues related to your student, email the counselor
 - For issues related to student safety and student behavior, email the grade-level Assistant Principal
 - o If you need to speak with/meet with someone, we recommend you either call the front office or email the person you want to meet with. Dropping in during the school day unannounced can be challenging, especially at the beginning and end of the school day. We would always recommend calling/emailing first, and if you do need to come in, we can make sure the person you need to speak with is available.

News and Notes:

Device Deployment – we will be deploying FCS devices to students on Monday morning. We will
follow the Testing/Special Activity Bell Schedule (<u>Testing/Special Activity Bell Schedule</u>) on
Monday and deploy during the extended Homeroom period.

As we shared prior to the open of school, we are asking families to provide a small device bag if they are able to, and your student should bring that with them on Monday morning. The bag should be no larger than 16"x12" and can have a strap. Large student bags/backpacks make movement in the classrooms and hallways more difficult, are more likely to cause damage to the devices, and create other safety risks as well. These should be left in students' lockers during the school day. If you are unable to provide this bag for your child, we will have something for them to use after we distribute devices.

- HMS is committed to providing a learning environment where students feel safe and supported. The following are a few "points of emphasis" related to that:
 - We conducted severe weather, fire, and lockdown drills this week. We shared a few very important points regarding safety as well, including:
 - During a drill or actual emergency, it is imperative that you listen to the staff member you are with. Phones and other electronic devices can be distracting and should not be used.
 - If you see (or hear) something, say something! We can't prevent or respond to issues we don't know about, so students should report concerns to a staff member ASAP.
 - All of our exterior doors are closed and locked during the school day. It is imperative that students never open a door for someone else without the permission of a staff member.
