Fulton County Schools Reaches Record Graduation Rate

The Georgia Department of Education (GADOE) released new data on Tuesday showing Fulton County Schools (FCS) with a 90.3 percent graduation rate, achieving the highest ever recorded graduation rate for the third year in a row. A total of 14 FCS high schools were over 90 percent, with three schools above 97 percent and six schools over 95 percent. We are so proud of all of the graduates!
