Red Ribbon Week (October 23-27) – Sponsored by our Counseling Department

Red Ribbon Week is an alcohol, tobacco, and other drug and violence prevention awareness campaign observed annually in October in the United States. At Shakerag, we communicate to our students the importance of making mindful and healthy choices in their lives, about respecting yourself, and respecting others. The National theme for this week is: **Be Kind to Your Mind. Live Drug Free**.

You can use the following topics as conversation starters at home.

- Monday (10/23)- Wear Red Day: We will talk about wearing red to remind students and adults to respect themselves and others, regardless of their differences.
- Tuesday (10/24)-Your Future is BRIGHT: Wear bright neon colors to show how bright our future is.
- Wednesday (10/25)- Team Day (wear your favorite team jersey or attire): We are all wearing our
 favorite team jersey or attire because, at Shakerag, we are all part of a team. We are each
 responsible for making healthy choices for ourselves, but we can also provide encouragement and
 support to our teammates so that they, too, can make healthy choices. When we work together to
 make healthy choices, we show respect for ourselves AND others.
- Thursday (10/26)- Wear Wild Socks to Sock it to Drugs: Wear your wildest socks today! You can talk about how dangerous it is to use drugs and the importance of being drug-free.
- Friday (10/27)- Characters of Success: Come dressed as your favorite storybook character or role
 model to remind us of what we aspire to be (We can't wait to see everyone's favorite characters and
 role models! As a reminder, no costume masks, props, inflatables, or inappropriate clothing are
 allowed. Children should be able to fully participate in the school day (recess, P.E., etc.)!)
