



## Creating opportunities for excellence...

#### Academics Overview

Alpharetta High School follows a traditional semester schedule. Students typically carry a full schedule of six classes, which may include dual enrollment/college classes, online courses and internship experiences. Cumulative numeric average (CNA) is calculated on a 100 point scale for each student and averages semester grades for each attempted course with the potential to

earn high school credit. Seven quality points are awarded to passing grades for honors, AP, IB, and dual enrollment/college courses taken while the student is enrolled at AHS. Courses taken prior to enrollment at AHS may or may not include honor points, depending on the prior school's policies.
