Each school year consists of two semesters with 0.5 units of credit awarded per course. Students can earn 6 credits per year.

Alpharetta High School follows a traditional semester schedule. Students must carry a full schedule of six classes, which can include dual enrollment/college classes, online courses and internship experiences.
