A. Principal's Report

B. Set SGC Goals (1-2)

The SGC's two pillars of focus for the remainder of this year are student achievement and community collaboration. Our goals are listed below:

1. To support student academic successes through collaboration with the CHS administration team, student engagement opportunities, and with the use of Charter Dollars to assist in the purchase of needed equipment and supplies.
2. To support the students through community collaboration efforts including the development of parent driven informational videos, with the utilization of the school bilingual liaison, and through results from the CHS parent survey to streamline resources for continued successes.

Discussions related to the importance of community engagement during this pandemic, concerns and blocks holding students back from academic achievement, parents not engaged in what their students are actually doing, seniors needing help to apply to colleges, the emotional state of students and parents, and service gaps.

The SGC will create a student and teacher survey. Questions will be created by the teachers. Survey results will be discussed at the January 21 SGC meeting.

The SGC will also begin to develop informational videos for parents to support continued engagement, and for multiple training opportunities.

C. Charter Dollar Discussion

Discussion regarding the use of charter dollars included webcams, devices, and electronics. Mr. Campbell mentioned the district has a plan for the needed equipment.

The SGC also discussed funding the part-time College and Career position it had funded previously beginning in January 2021. The position was not funded this year. The position offers vital assistance to students and families with college applications and scholarships. Mr. Campbell will confirm the actual expense.
