## **School board to meet July 14 at North Learning Center and July 23 at South Learning Center**

The Fulton County Board of Education will meet Tuesday, July 14 at the Fulton County School District's North Learning Center, located at 450 Northridge Parkway in Sandy Springs.

The schedule for July 14 is as follows:

- At 11:00 a.m. the first of two FY21 public millage rate hearings will occur
- Immediately following the public millage rate hearing, the Board will adjourn into executive session
- The public board meeting will be being immediately after executive session, at approximately 12:00 p.m.
- At 6:00 p.m. the Board will hold a second public millage rate hearing

The Board will also meet on Thursday, July 23, at the Fulton County School District's South Learning Center, located at 4025 Flat Shoals Road in Union City.

The schedule for July 23 is as follows:

- At 5:00 p.m. the Board will meet and adjourn into executive session
- At 6:00 p.m. the Board will hold the third FY21 public millage rate hearing
- The remainder of the public Board meeting will begin immediately after the public millage rate hearing, at approximately 6:30 p.m.

All meetings of the School Board are open to the public unless designated as executive session, where the Board convenes in private to discuss land, legal or personnel items.

Social distancing will be practiced at all meetings and hearings, and therefore space for attendees may be reduced.
