OUR AGENCY

We are a trauma-informed agency that recognizes and emphasizes an understanding of how a traumatic experience impacts an individual's mental, behavioral, emotional, physical, and spiritual well-being.

The types of therapy we provide are evidence-based methods including TFCBT (Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy), FFT (Family Functional Therapy), and CBITS (Cognitive Behavioral Intervention for Trauma in Schools).

Family Ties provides behavioral health services for students in elementary, middle, and high school. The goal of this programs to increase students' ability to manage behavioral and emotional challenges, leading to enhanced student and school performance by decreasing disruptive behaviors
