All books returned will be quarantined for a minimum of 24 hours before checked out to the next student. If a specific title requested isn't available, we will do our best to find a similar book. Did you know free & reduced-price meal applications benefit your family and your school?! Families may qualify for free or reduced-price school breakfast & lunch. If you have not already completed a Free and Reduced application, or if your income has decreased for any reason since you last applied or if your household size has increased, please take this opportunity to complete the application. FCS FoodStop Student Meals Now Available

When Universal Remote Learning was announced the Fulton County School Nutrition Program knew one of the top priorities included continuing to provide nutritious meals for all FCS students. The FCS FoodStop drive-thru model will be utilized to distribute weekly meals at 22 school sites throughout the district. The FCS FoodStop provides an opportunity for families to drive-up and pick up Grab & Go meal kits for students. Drivers are not to leave their vehicles; however, walk-ups are allowed. Each FoodStop Meal Distribution Site will only serve students from specific feeder schools.

FCS FoodStop Meal Distribution Sites will be open on **Wednesdays from 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.** The cost of the meal kits will include five breakfast meals and five lunch meals.

Student Meal Prices Per Week:
Elementary School Breakfast & Lunch Meal Kits : \$17.75
Reduced-Price Breakfast & Lunch Meal Kits : \$3.50

FoodStop sites will remain contactless during food distribution. Families are asked to prepay for student meals online, complete Free & Reduced Meal applications online, and utilize Student Meal Barcodes at FCS Foodstops.
