## Drop Off and Pickup Times

Morning Drop-off is from 7:10—7:40am  
Afternoon Pickup is at 2:20pm

Parents, drop-off (for face-to-face learning in the building) is from 7:10 – 7:40 a.m. If a child arrives past 7:40 a.m. on a day that they are physically attending River Eves, they are late to school. **If you arrive late, you must park your car and walk your child in to school to sign them in. Before entering school, you must follow the required Health Screening protocol which is outlined below.** Thank you for doing your best to get your child to school on time!

## Parent/Family Member Health Screenings

If/When parents or other family members come to River Eves to attend to school business (front office access only), please note that Fulton County Schools is requiring a “Wellness Check” for all non-employees that visit the school building. **Please bring a cell phone as you must scan a QR code that is displayed on the front doors** (leading into the school building) and then respond to an electronic questionnaire. **Temperature checks will also be administered** by the River Eves Clinic Assistant (Miss Tammy) before you may enter the school. **Also, no one may enter the office area without wearing a protective mask over your nose & mouth.**

## Wednesday Instruction During Phases 3 & 4

During the three weeks of phases 3 & 4, the weekly Wednesday structure will be no live, digital instructional delivery from teachers to students. All teachers will provide asynchronous (not live instruction) work/activities on this one day per week when we do not have students physically present within the building. Teachers will be available for conferences and small groups on Microsoft Teams and will push out lessons using the Seesaw platform, as well as the use of iReady reading and math practice. This will provide all teaching staff one day per week to plan for simultaneous face-to-face/digital instruction. Please note that this structure will only be in place for the three weeks during Phases 3 & 4.

## Fulton County Schools FREE School Meals for Kids

### Free Lunch and Breakfast offered throughout First Semester!

Effective through the end of the 1st semester (December 2020): All Fulton County Schools students will eat school breakfasts and lunches "free of charge." Keep in mind that this will only last through the end of the first semester. In January of 2021, families will begin paying for lunches or will be participating in the free and reduced food program. Please note that if you are interested in the free and reduced meal program, you must complete an application as soon as possible if you have not already done so. Applications will not be available in December or January. Apply now!

Until further notice, the River Eves School cafeteria will not be selling additional snacks (at lunchtime) to students.

### 2nd-5th Grade Laptops During Face To Face Learning

#### Phases 3&4 (Face-To-Face Learning: One or Two Days Per Week)

For 2nd-5th Grade Students Attending "Phase 3 & 4" Face-To-Face Learning: Please bring your assigned Fulton County Schools student laptop with you on your assigned day of the week during "Phase 3" and also on your assigned days of the week during "Phase 4." The laptop will go home with the student at the conclusion of the school day during these two phases only. Also, bring your assigned charging cord, as well. All laptop hardware MUST be carried/transported in a student book bag or laptop bag.

For those 2nd-5th grade students that do not yet have an assigned Fulton County Schools laptop device, due to the fact that they have been using a device at home: These students will be assigned a device for the days that they are attending face-to-face learning (at River Eves) during phases 3 & 4. Please note that the assigned device will remain at school, since the student is already using a home device on other digital learning days.

#### Phase 5 (Face-To-Face Learning: Five Days Per Week)

All 2nd-5th grade students attending "Phase 5" instruction will leave their assigned Fulton County Schools laptop device at school. It will be waiting on them to use (each day) upon their return to the building for face-to-face learning. "Phase 5" will begin on Wednesday, October 14th.
