Free & Reduced Lunch / Title One Status Benefits

October 31 Application Deadline, Apply Today!



To qualify for Title 1 status, we need to be at 35% of our students qualifying for "free or reduced lunch" services to receive annual Title 1 monies for the school. If we qualify,

these monies will translate into thousands of dollars to support the students of River Eves Elementary. We are currently at 31.4% of our student population having qualified for the "free and reduced lunch" program.

If you believe that your household may be eligible, based on your income, please apply as soon as possible. Please note that the current circumstances, where all River Eves students are receiving free breakfast and/or lunch will expire at the end of December. Beginning in January, students will no longer be receiving free breakfast and lunch. Students that have not been approved for the program will be charged for eating at school. If students do not have money in their account, they will be served a cheese sandwich and milk after not having paid for three lunches. The application deadline is Monday, October 31st. 

COVID-19 Reporting Portal

The Fulton County Board of Health and Fulton County Schools have developed an on-line portal for FCS parents/guardians to report student COVID-19 related cases. Please make a report to the FCBOH when your student is **COVID-19 positive, has a pending COVID-19 test result, or has been in direct contact with a COVID-19 positive person**. Also, please use this resource for official reporting rather than alerting the school and/or teacher. If you must engage the school/teacher, please do so after you have made an official report to the FCBOH. Lastly, to ensure the protection of our school community, please **do not** allow your child to attend school or school-sponsored events when he/she is ill and/or has any of the above COVID-19 concerns. **Please reference the attached flyer and consider posting it in a visible location in your home for easy access.** Thank you and please stay safe.

Drop Off and Pickup Times

Morning Drop-off is from 7:10–7:40am

Afternoon Pickup is at 2:20pm

Parents, drop-off (for face-to-face learning in the building) is from 7:10 – 7:40 a.m. If a child arrives past 7:40 a.m. on a day that they are physically attending River Eves, they are late to school.

If you arrive late, you must park your car and walk your child in to school to sign them in. Before entering school, you must follow the required Health Screening protocol outlined below. Thanks for doing your best to get your child to school on time!

Parent/Family Member Health Screenings to Enter Building

If/When parents or other family members come to River Eves to attend to school business (front office access only), please note that Fulton County Schools is requiring a "Wellness Check" for all non-employees that visit the school building. **Please bring a cell phone as you must scan a QR code that is displayed on the front doors** (leading into the school building) and then respond to an electronic questionnaire.

Temperature checks will also be administered by the River Eves Clinic Assistant (Miss Tammy) before you may enter the school. **Also, no one may enter the office area without a protective mask over your nose and mouth.**

Dismissal Change Policy

For the security of our students, all Dismissal Changes must be in writing and received by 1:30 PM. Changes may be faxed to 470-254-4557.
