There are conversations happening at the county level about how to respond. Mr. Downey wants us to be aware that those conversations are happening. There have been a few schools that have shut down for a short period of time. NHS has not had any cases/quarantines due to spread of the virus at NHS. Mr. Downey has been getting questions about 2nd semester, but that information has not come out from the county yet. Mr. Downey will communicate any information as soon as he has it.</p>	Brian Downey
4:15 p.m.	<p>Informational Item: SGC Funds</p> <p>Within the purchases there are items focusing on technology for the current teaching model and equipment for CBI program and other special needs programs. Ms. Bombard commented that she will follow up with Ms. Dismuke to see how these funds may be useful in supporting our upcoming professional development. Once the state releases SGC funds, the district allocates a certain percentage to each school. Mr. Downey shared that our most pressing need involves technology. The school board is purchasing monitors, wireless microphones, and document cameras. Since the funds are coming from the school board, the SGC won't have to spend as much money.
