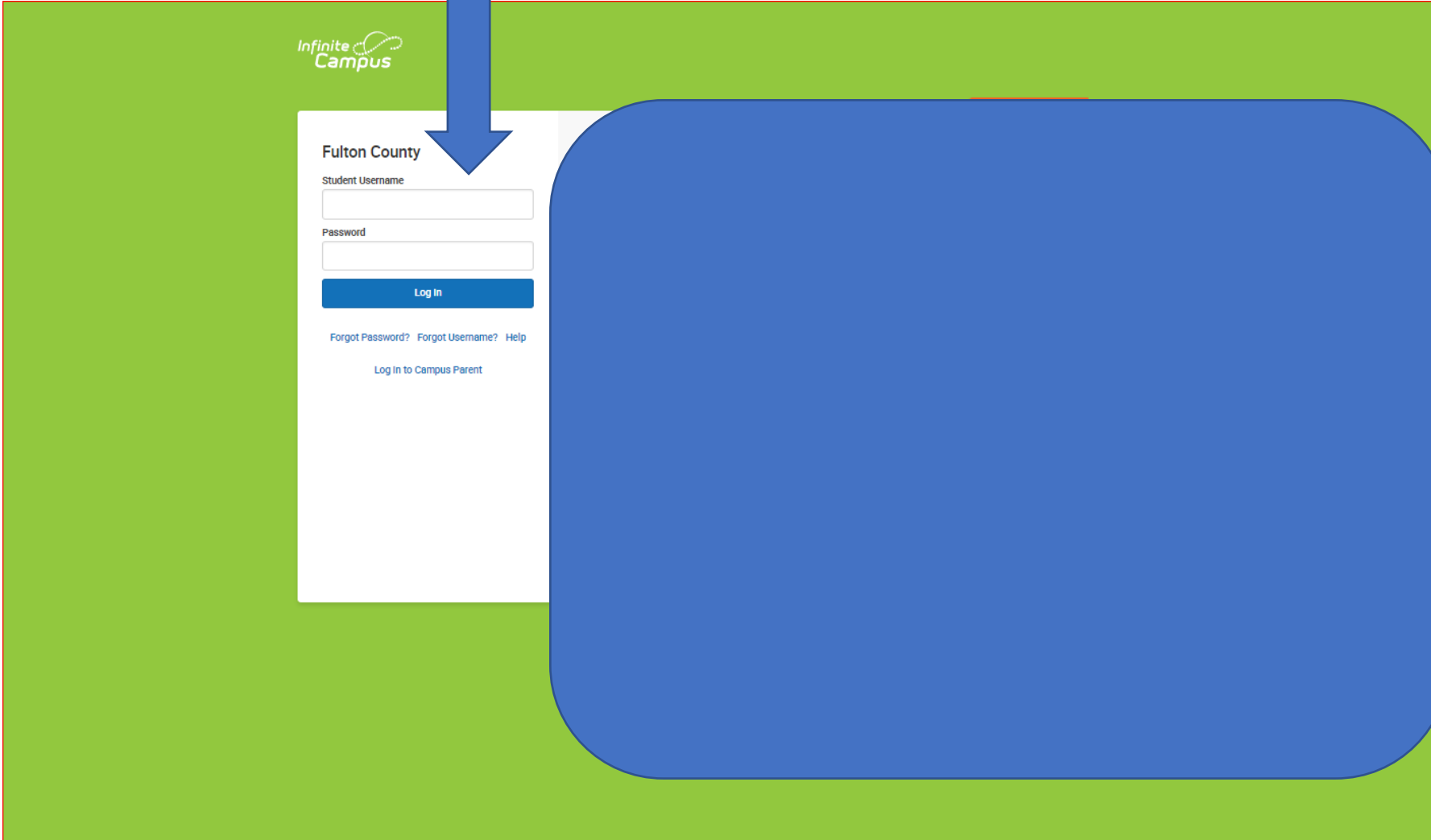

# What's Next?

**February 24:** Deadline to submit electives

**March 1- 7:** Counselors verify course requests to make sure students have the necessary/correct courses

**March 8:** Verification #1

- Students view electronically through Infinite Campus their course requests
- Class change form will be available to submit to counselors

**March 15:** Verification #2

- Students view electronically through Infinite Campus their course requests
- Class change form will be available to submit to counselors

# Frequently Asked Questions

- What if I want to take an AP class? How does that work?
  - This will take place during Verification #1 and #2
- How many electives can I take?
  - We will have 8 periods next year; it depends on how many core classes you need
- What about pre-requisites and teacher sign off?
  - CHECK THE COURSE CATALOG!
- Art Classes – most require a two semester sign up
- What if it says I do not have enough credit?
  - Make sure to add 3-4 electives and counselors will be checking your academic plan soon
- What about reduced schedule? Dual-enrollment?
  - These will be handled at a later date with different processes and electives can be dropped at that time
- What does an M mean next to a course?
  - This stands for a magnet course; magnet students get first priority in taking these classes
