Course Placement Waiver Statement 2021-2022

I have waived into a course that I was NOT recommended for. I understand that:

- This is a more challenging course and will require more work on my part
- The teacher of the course is under no obligation to provide me with assistance or tutoring above or beyond what is available to other students
- If I perform poorly in the requested course, it may affect my scheduling options- Numeric Average/GPA, graduation progress, honors and awards, college options, and scholarship opportunities.
- This waiver is contingent upon space availability
- I will not be able to drop this course after the first 10 days of the semester despite difficulties I may experience.

Specifically for an AP course, I understand that:

- AP courses require in-depth study and a willingness to go beyond usual class requirements and preparation (including summer reading). I am willing to invest the time and effort.
- Some AP courses require pre-requisite courses that I may not have taken which could affect my background skills and knowledge needed for this course
- If I **fail** the AP course first semester. I may be withdrawn from the class for second semester.
- If it is necessary for me to use recovery during first semester to pass the course, it may be recommended that I withdraw from the class for second semester (**if failed course**).
