After reading, think about a connection you have to the story. Have you ever done something like this or felt like the character? Tell someone in your family how the mother and baby are alike and different.</p>	<p><b>S/SS:</b> Plants</p> <p>Take a nature walk and observe two different plants.</p> <p>Draw and label a picture of each plant and tell how they are alike and different.</p>	<p><b>S/SS:</b> Celebrating Our Nation</p> <p>Watch this video about <a href="#">Symbols of America</a>.</p> <p>Draw and label a picture of a symbol of America that you learned about.</p>
