Reminder that this Monday, September 20th is a Fulton County Schools Late Start Monday. This is a **one-hour delayed start for every school in the district**. AHS will have an adjusted bell schedule with 1st period starting at 9:20 a.m. Busses run at regular times on Late Start Days, so students without their own transportation to school will ride their bus at regular time and have a study hall in the cafeteria or media center. Please keep in mind that carpool drop off will be heavier than a typical day, so please plan accordingly with more time to get to campus.
