Information Item - Principal's Update (Brian Jones)

- Device deployment last week – county was initially short on devices due to supply chain issues – elementary schools are currently short on devices
- Map testing early September – had to push back due to device distribution delayed to 2nd week of school
- 10 day count – FCS projected a count of 2054 for MHS; FCS recorded an actual count of 2015 last week; MHS counted a total of 2035 on Friday, 8/19. Due to the drop from initial county projection, FCS would require MHS to lose a full teaching position. Mr. Jones budgets in for an extra teacher so will not be as impactful. MHS will advocate to not lose the position based on the historical data of enrollment increasing by 15-20 after Labor Day.
