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Good Morning Raiders,

13 ½ week grades have been posted. Please review those grades in Infinite Campus and reach out to your teacher with any questions. We now have only 4 weeks remaining in the semester. Let's encourage all our students to finish strong!

As a reminder, the last three days of fall semester are December 14th, 15th, and 16th. These days are ½ days only with the school day ending at 12:30. Class periods are 2 hours long and we only have two classes per day. Students should clarify with each of your teachers what the expectations will be for your class on the final days of the semester. Students in semester only courses may have final exams. Students in year long courses may have mid-term exams. Teachers are not required to give exams. If a course does not include an exam, students still have an assignment to complete on these days which we often refer to as a “gradable experience” because it could be a project, a presentation, an essay or even a quiz. Remember that a student's course determines the assignment for the last day of the semester, so be certain to get clarification now in order to be prepared. We do have an exemption policy which is posted to our website. Please note that mid term exams are not eligible for exemption. Students with gradable experiences as the assignment for the final day of the semester may exempt the assignment if the student has an unweighted average of 90 or above.
