## INTERNATIONAL NIGHT EMCEE AUDITIONS!

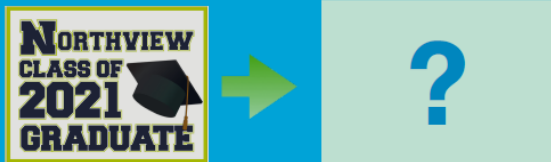
